GOALS

- To spend some time discussing and thinking more about how God reveals himself to us as Jesus, the Son
- To consider and internalize the rich blessing that God, 3-in-1, is

HEADLINES

Delighting in the Trinity Series:

Until we know and enjoy God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, we are in a music-less universe of deep darkness. PRAYER

DISCUSSION

1. What stood out for you in Sunday's message? Any points that seemed new or you hadn't thought of before?
2. Who in the Holy Trinity do you find you most often think about? Why do you think this is?

Someone read the following scripture: Hebrews 1

3. What does this scripture suggest about how Jesus is described and about what he came to do on earth?
 1. What does it mean that Jesus is God's revelation to the world?
 2. What impact should it have on our lives knowing that Jesus actually upholds everything by His power?
 3. What has been your experience of Jesus? How did you become a Christ-follower? (Life Group Leader, this could be a good opportunity for individuals to share their salvation testimony. It is a good way to develop community. Some may not have a salvation story yet, so be sensitive to how you lead this – maybe add: If you do not yet consider yourself a Christ-follower, what about Jesus has been drawing you to exploring more about faith in him?)

PRAY

Spend some time praying in gratitude for your salvation stories.

To end prayer: Lord Jesus, thank you for your grace and mercy given to us. Thank you for dying the death we couldn't die to live the eternal life we shouldn't be able to live. Help us grow more in you as we leave tonight and keep us safe until we meet again. Amen.
